[Europa Nostra](#) and its partner organisations working with youth in cultural heritage are launching a wide consultation on '[Youth for the Future of Cultural Heritage in Europe?](#)' as a contribution to the [European Year of Youth 2022](#).

The consultation is developed in collaboration with the [European Students' Association for Cultural Heritage](#) (ESACH), the [Erasmus Student Network](#) (ESN), the [European Heritage Tribune](#) (EHT), [The Future is Heritage](#), [Europeana Initiative Diversity & Inclusion Task Force](#), [ICOMOS Emerging Professionals Working Group](#) and the [European Heritage Volunteers](#).

The survey aims to:

- explore young people's visions on how cultural heritage should be integrated into key aspects of society: digital transformation, peacebuilding, sustainable development, tourism...
- find out the degree of satisfaction of young people regarding the way cultural heritage is addressed at European level;
- bring to light the main challenges young professionals, students, volunteers or enthusiasts are facing when interacting with and within the sector.

The responses will be gathered and result in a policy paper which seeks to trigger concrete actions to foster youth involvement in the cultural heritage sector and thus ensure a long-term legacy of the European Year of Youth 2022.
