The main topics of the 2016 event are the long-term archiving strategies of migration and emulation.

A group of experts will present their experiences with migration and emulation procedures. Among these, Peter Pharow (Fraunhofer IDMT) and Stefan Rohde-Enslin (SPK) will present the [PREFORMA](#) project.

In the afternoon, participants will have the opportunity to share their own experiences and to ask questions to the attending experts. In addition to the lecture program, various institutions and companies will showcase their solutions at presentation stands.
