The 7 Most Endangered Programme, launched in 2013, is run by <u>Europa Nostra</u>]in partnership with the European Investment Bank Institute and with the support of the Creative Europe programme of the European Union.

It is part of a civil society campaign to **save Europe's endangered heritage** and provides a grant of ?10,000 per listed site to assist in implementing an agreed activity that will contribute to saving the threatened site.

After <u>the launch, last 29th June, of the Call for Nominations</u> by Europa Nostra, the applications were discussed by an international Advisory Panel, comprising experts in history, archaeology, architecture, conservation, project analysis and finance, which selected 12 endangered heritage sites:
